# Methodological note

- Data collection through Customs (SAD500)
- Trade flow: purpose (direct consumption, warehousing, repair, processing etc.)
- Trade flow: aggregation (i.e. imports, re-imports, exports, re-exports and **transit**)
- System (General & Special)

# Snapshot

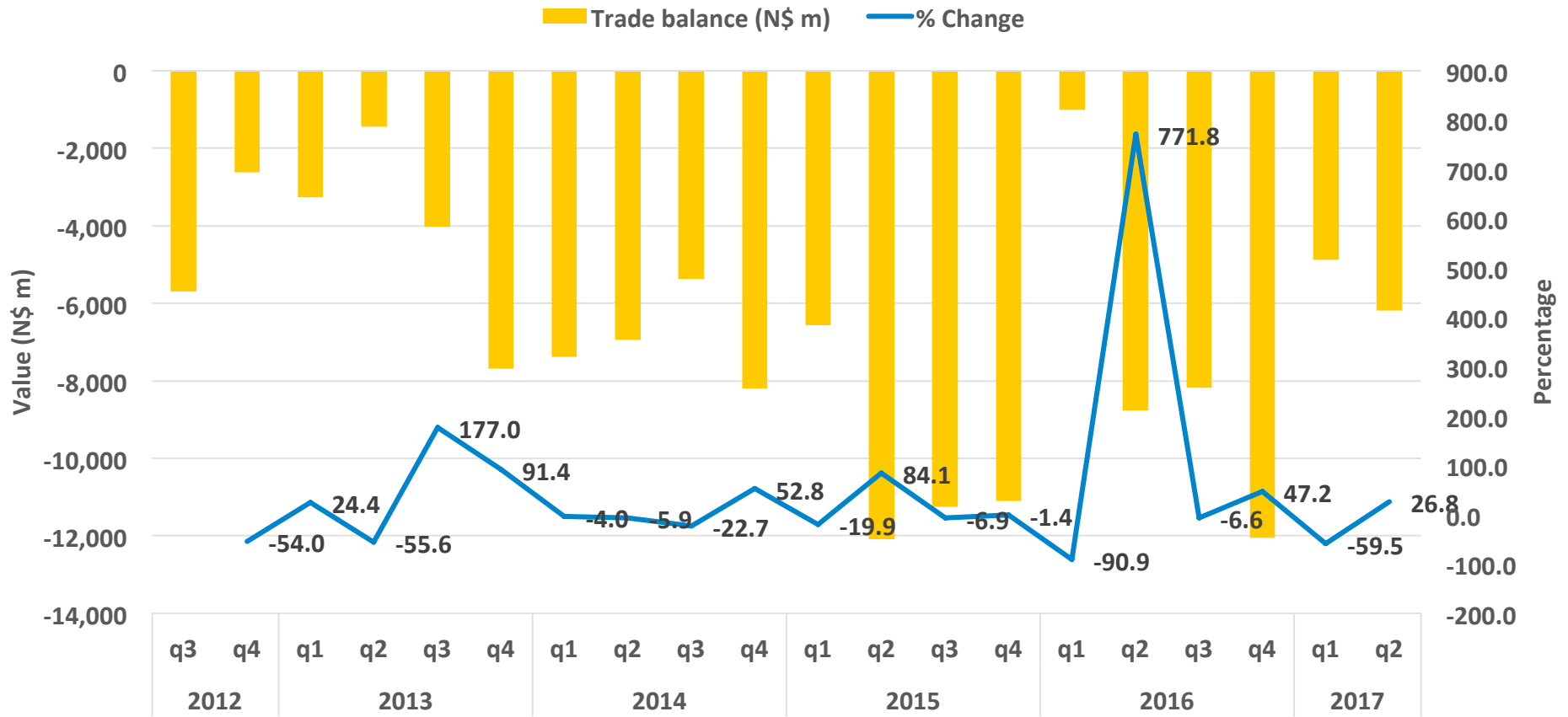
- Exports: N\$13.9 billion/N\$15.4 billion
- Decline 9.8%
- Imports: N\$20.3 billion/N\$24.2 billion
- Decline 16.9%
- Deficit: N\$6.2 billion
- Narrowed 29.3%
- After recording N\$8.8 billion in q2-2016.

# Snapshot cont'.....

- South Africa still the largest trading partner exports (22.7%) and imports (60.4%)
- Top imported commodities were fuel and vehicles
- Top exported commodities were diamonds, copper ores and fish.
- Imports were transported by way of road, while exports were mostly by sea.

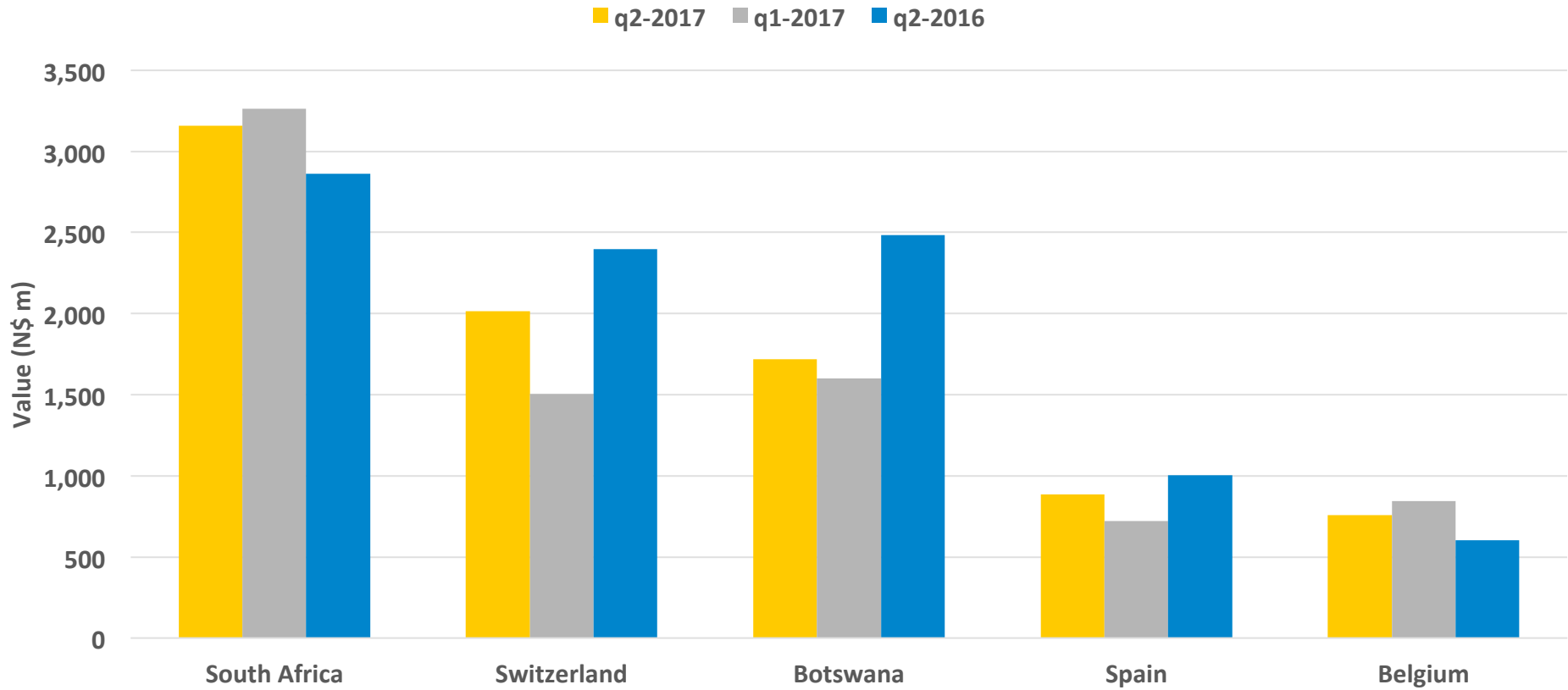

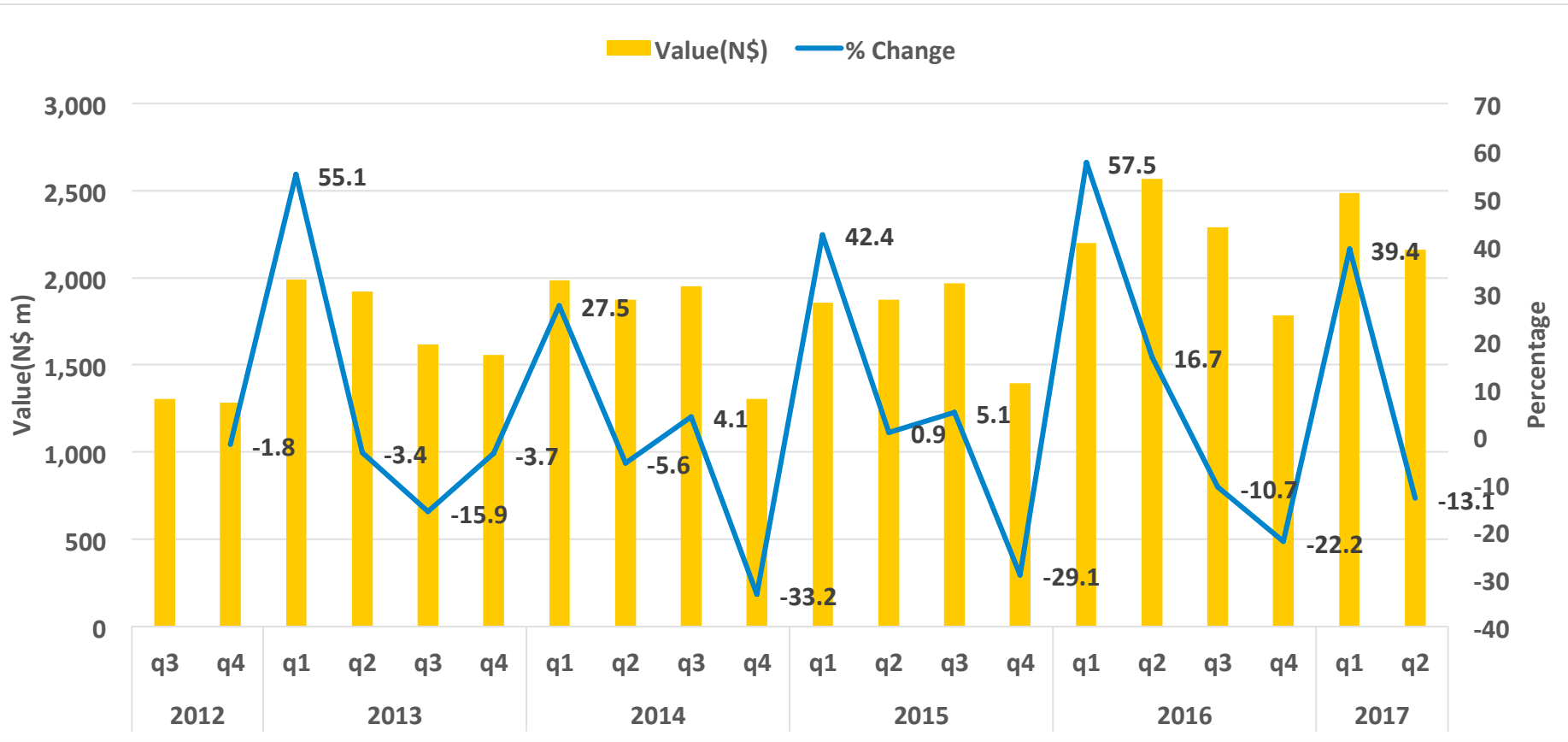

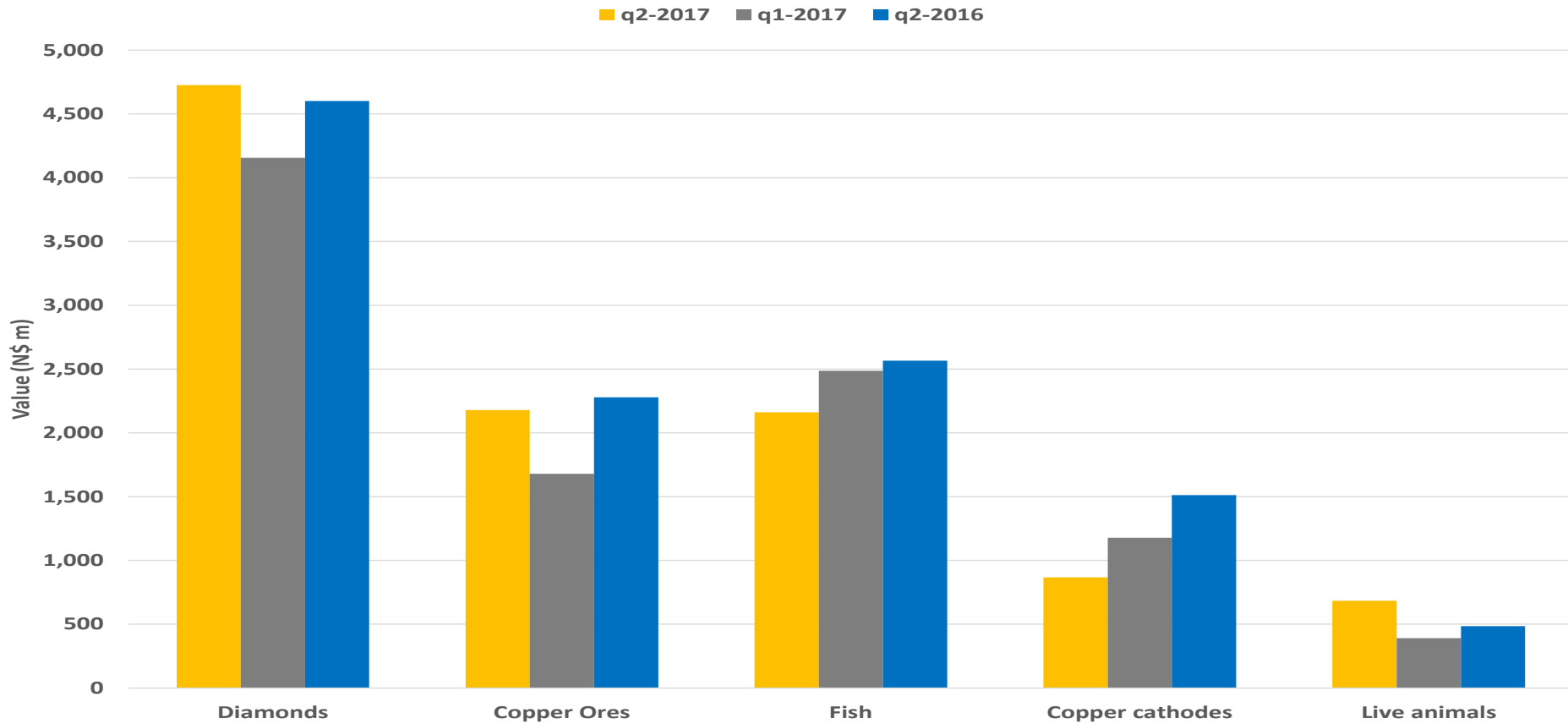

# Main export commodities



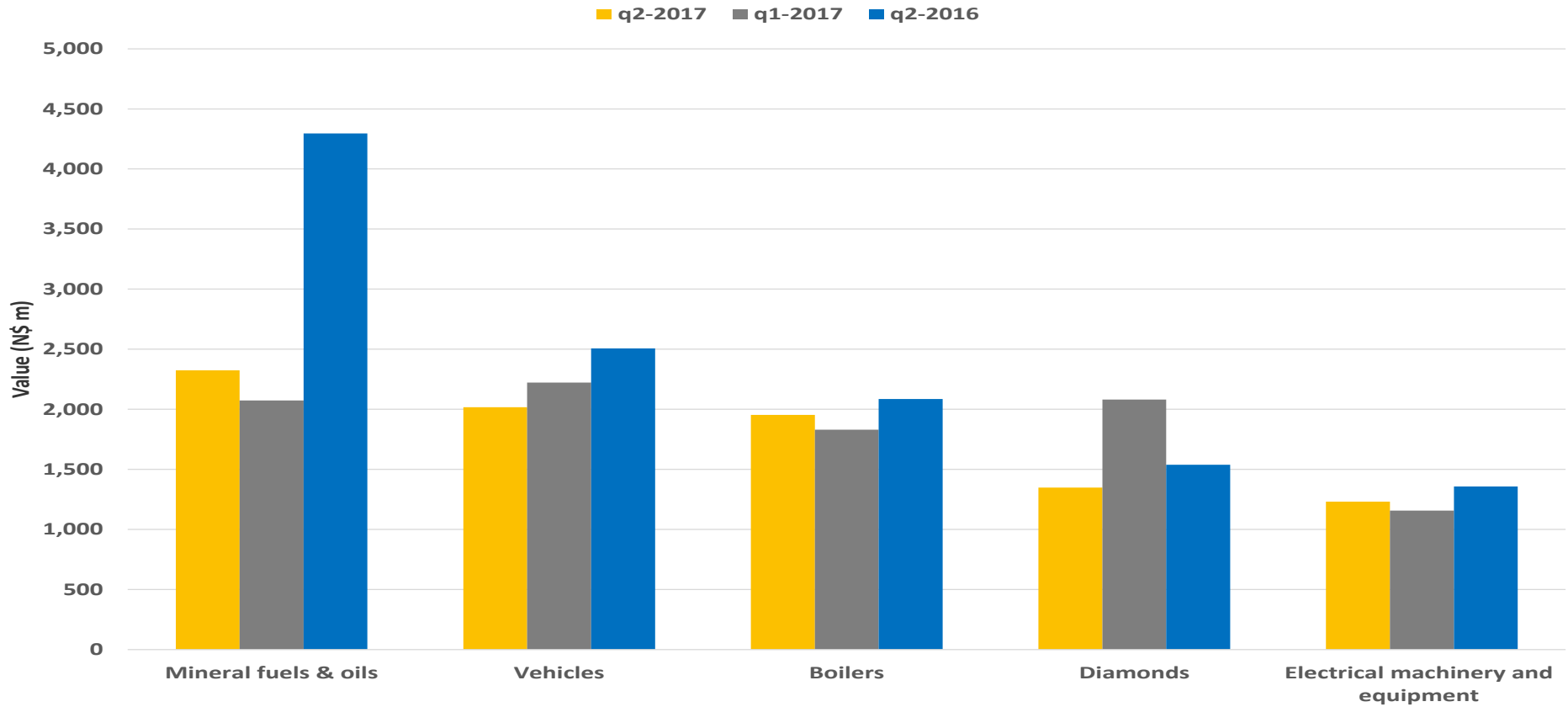

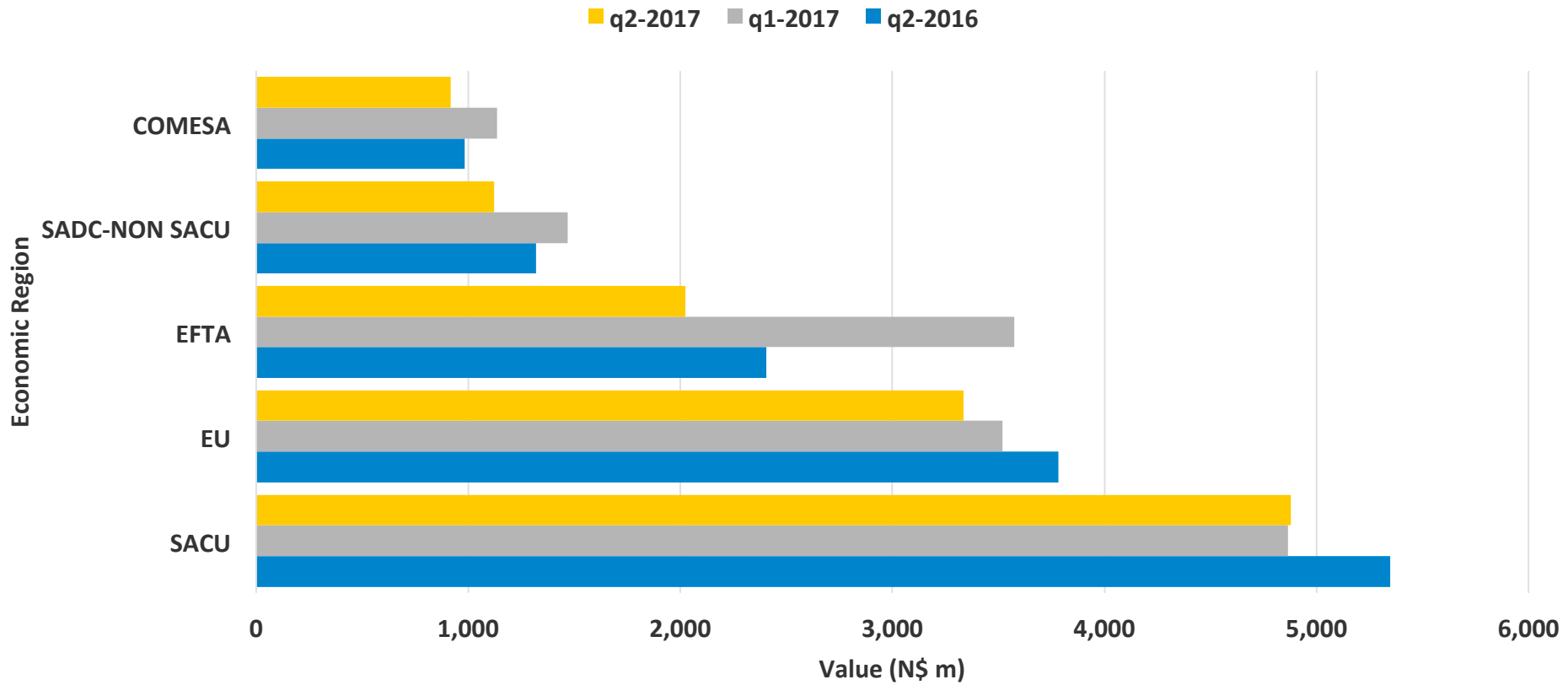

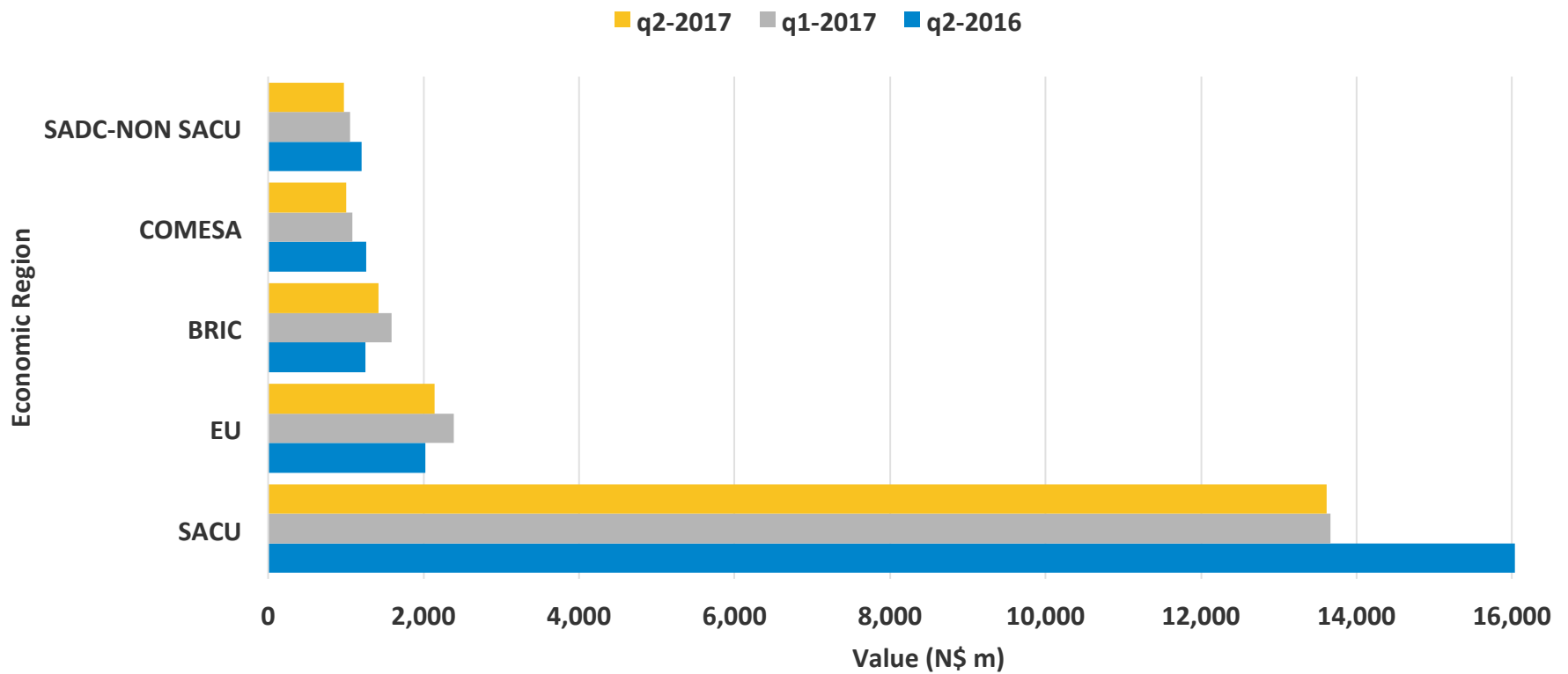

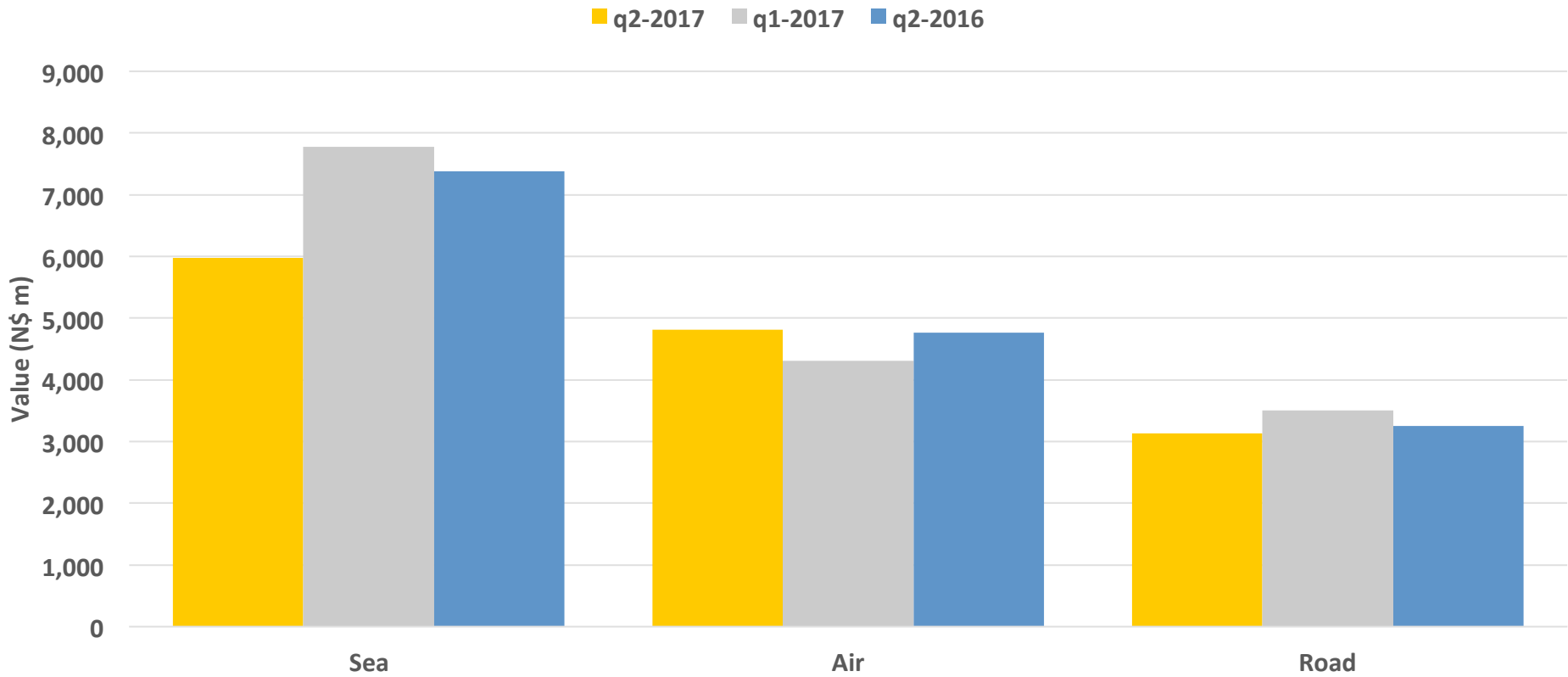

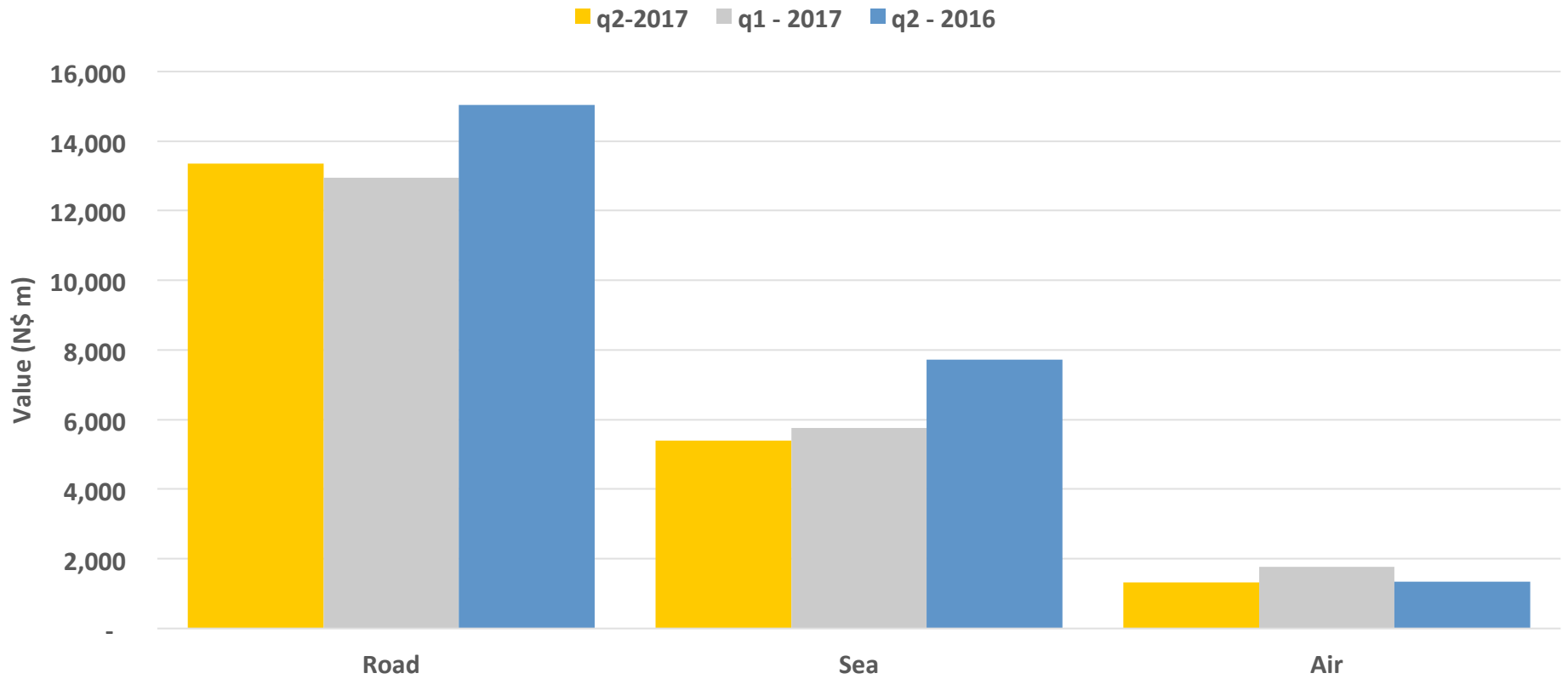
