# Methodological note

- Data collection through Customs (SAD500)
- Trade type: purpose (direct consumption, warehousing, repair, processing etc.)
- Trade flow: aggregation (imports, re-imports, exports, re-exports and **transit**)
- System (General & Special)

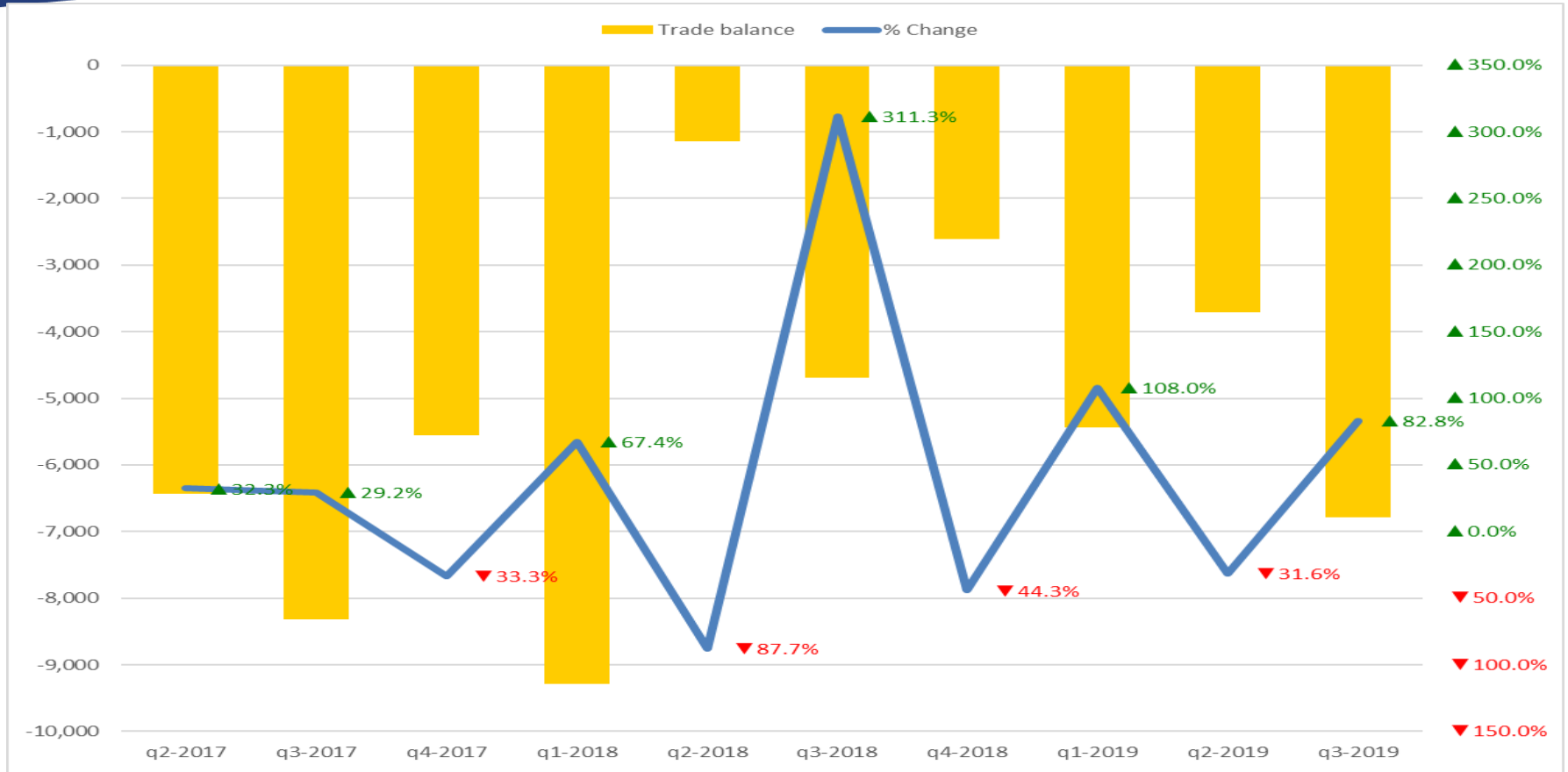
# Snapshot

- Exports: **N\$19.4 billion**/N\$25.2 billion
- Decline 23%
- Imports: **26.2 billion**/N\$29.9 billion
- decline 5%
- Deficit: **N\$6.8 billion**
- Deterioration: 45%
- After recording a deficit of **N\$4.7 billion** in q3-2018.

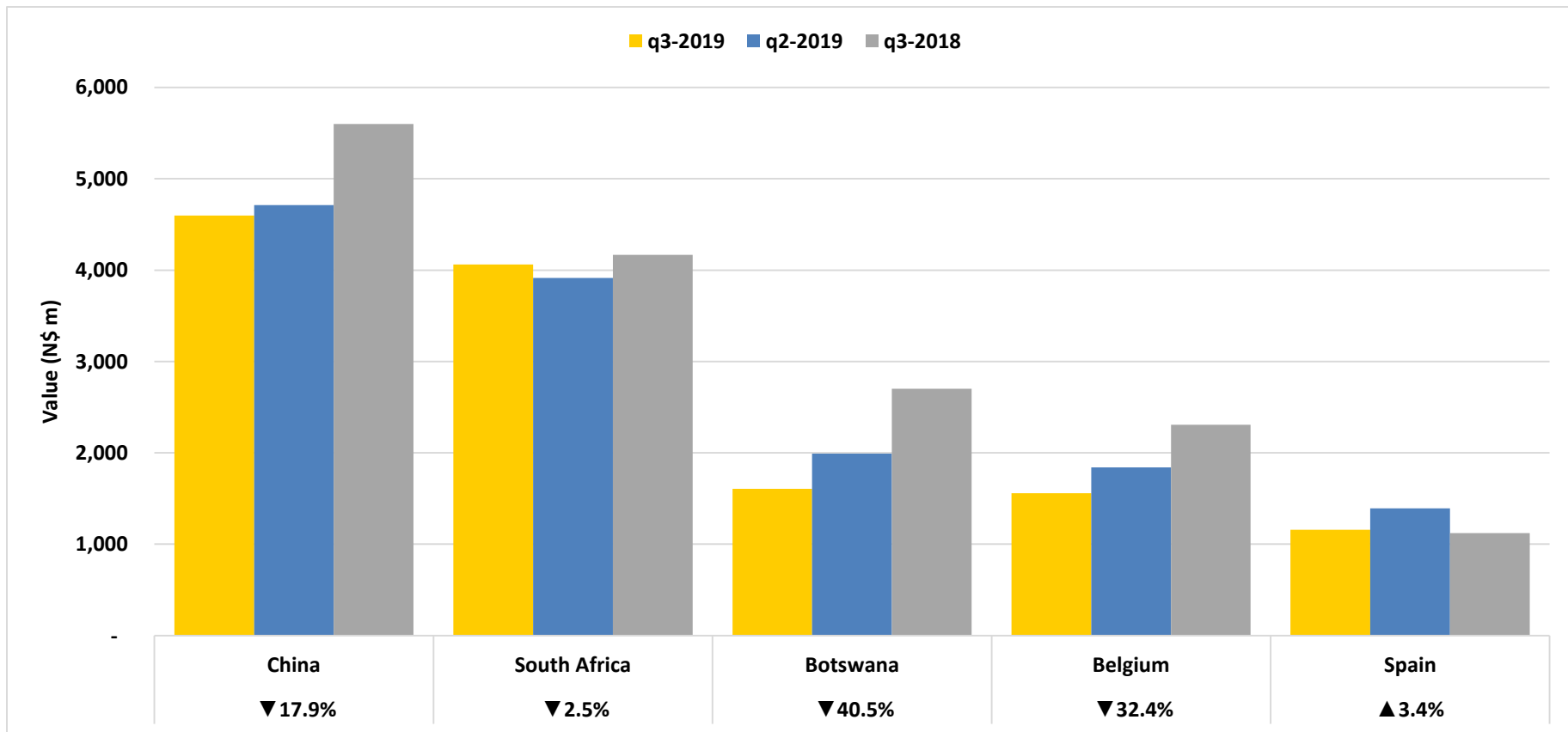
# Snapshot cont.'....

- Main export destinations China (24%), South Africa (21%), followed by Botswana & Belgium (8%)
- Main source of imports South Africa (50%), Zambia (16%) and China (4%)
- Top exported commodities were copper; precious stones and metals; and fish.
- Top imported commodities were copper, mineral oils & fuels as well as vehicles & parts
- Imports were transported by way of road (66%), while exports were mostly by sea (54%).

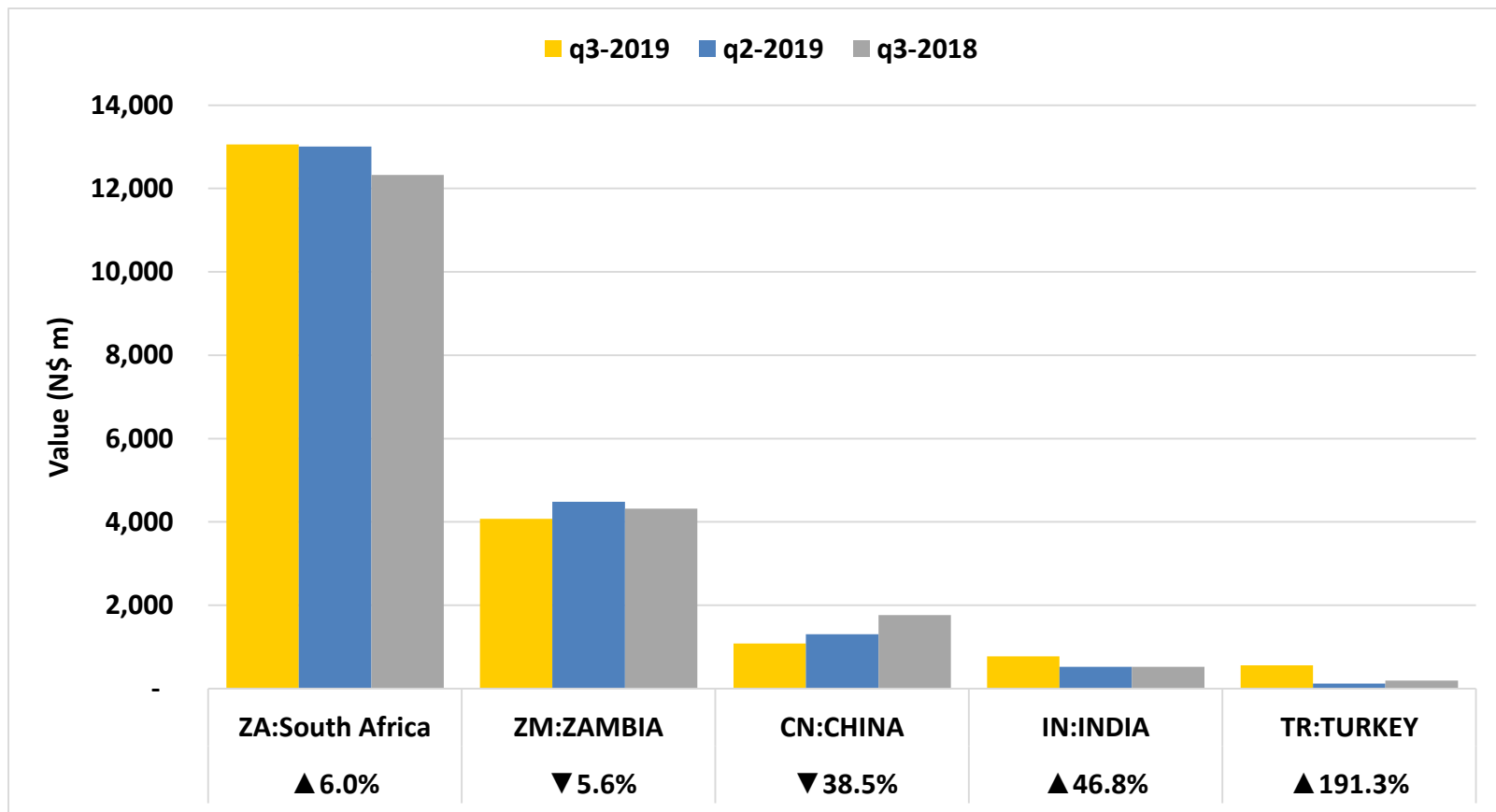

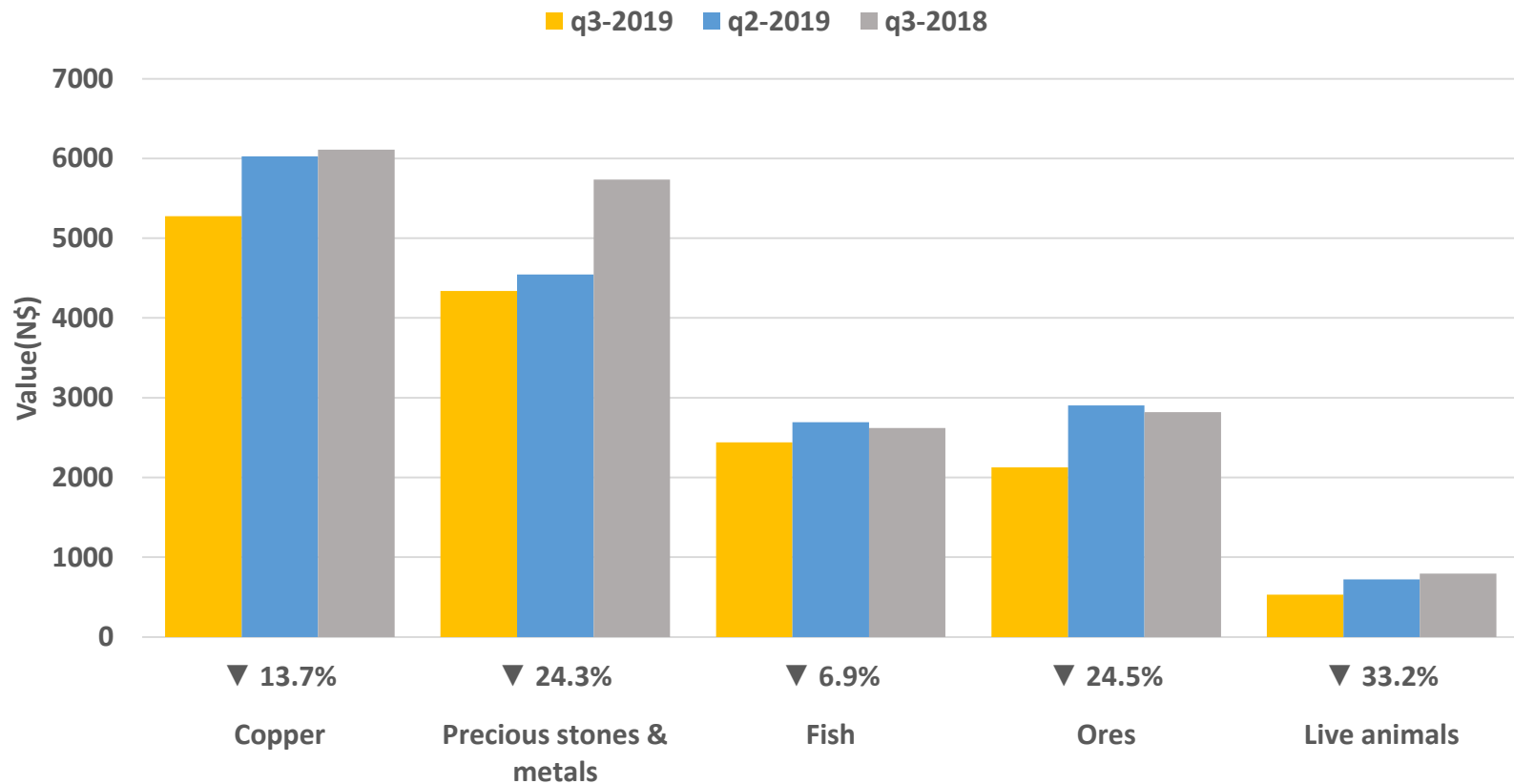


# Top 5 Sources of Imports

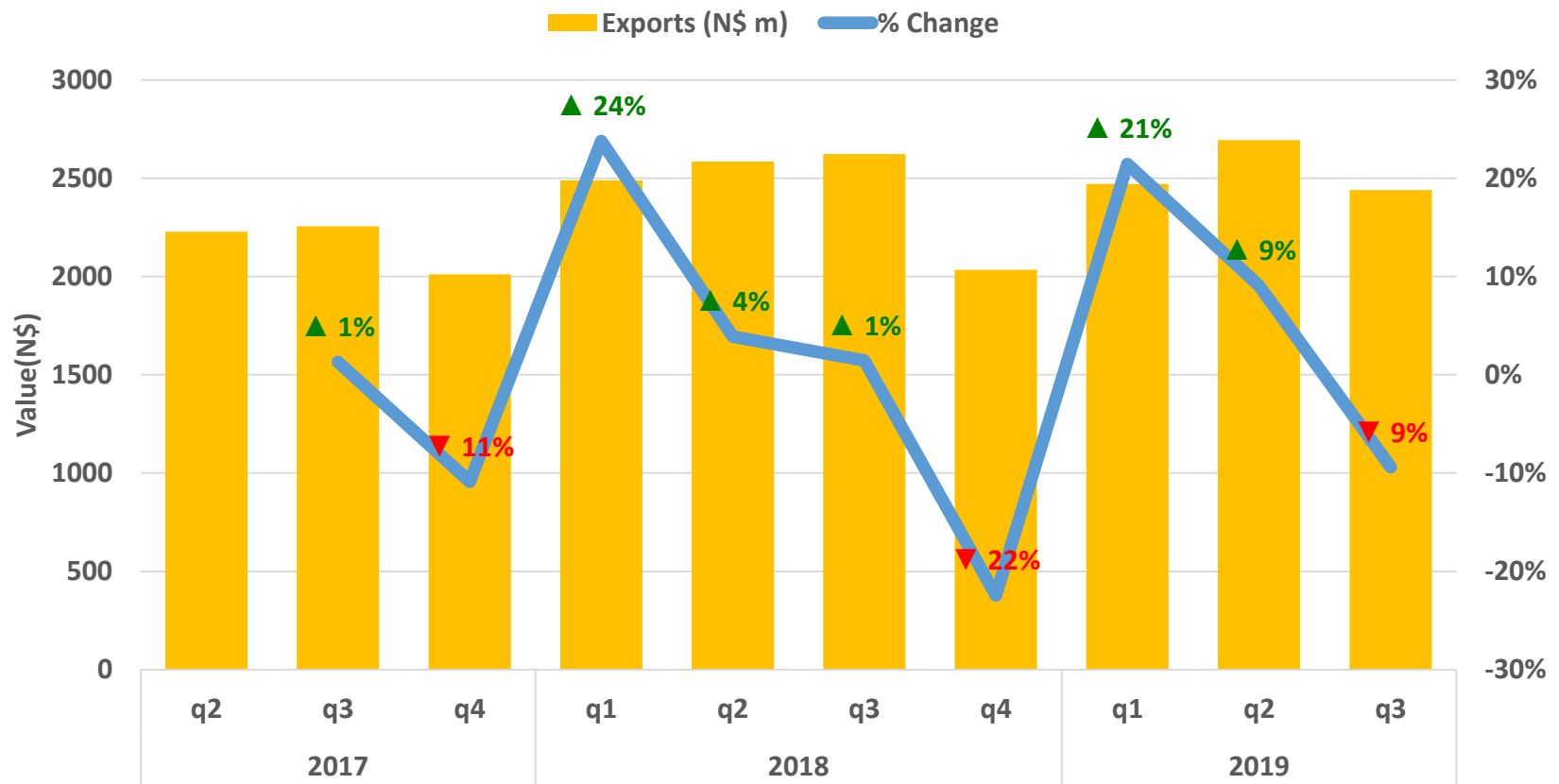




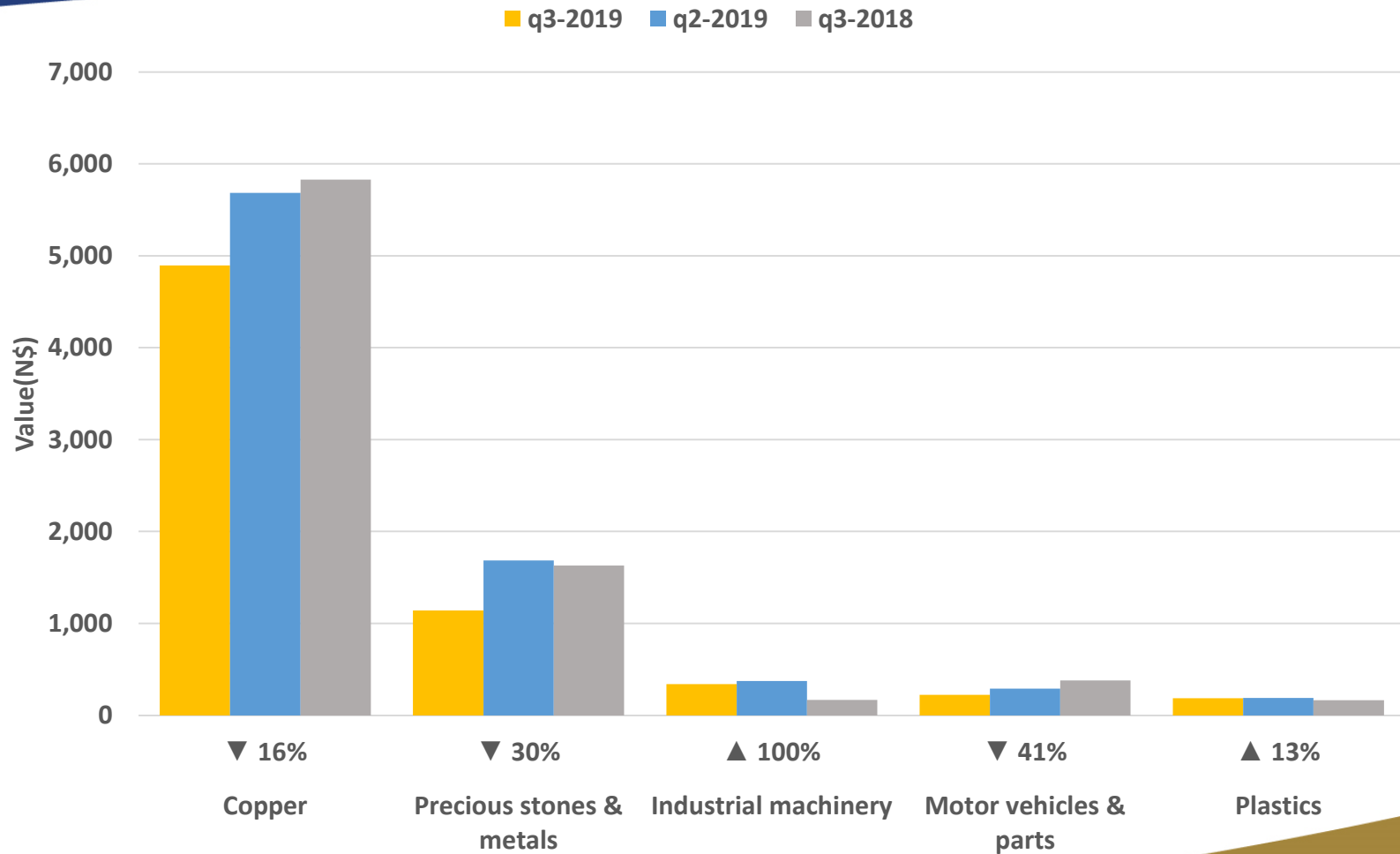

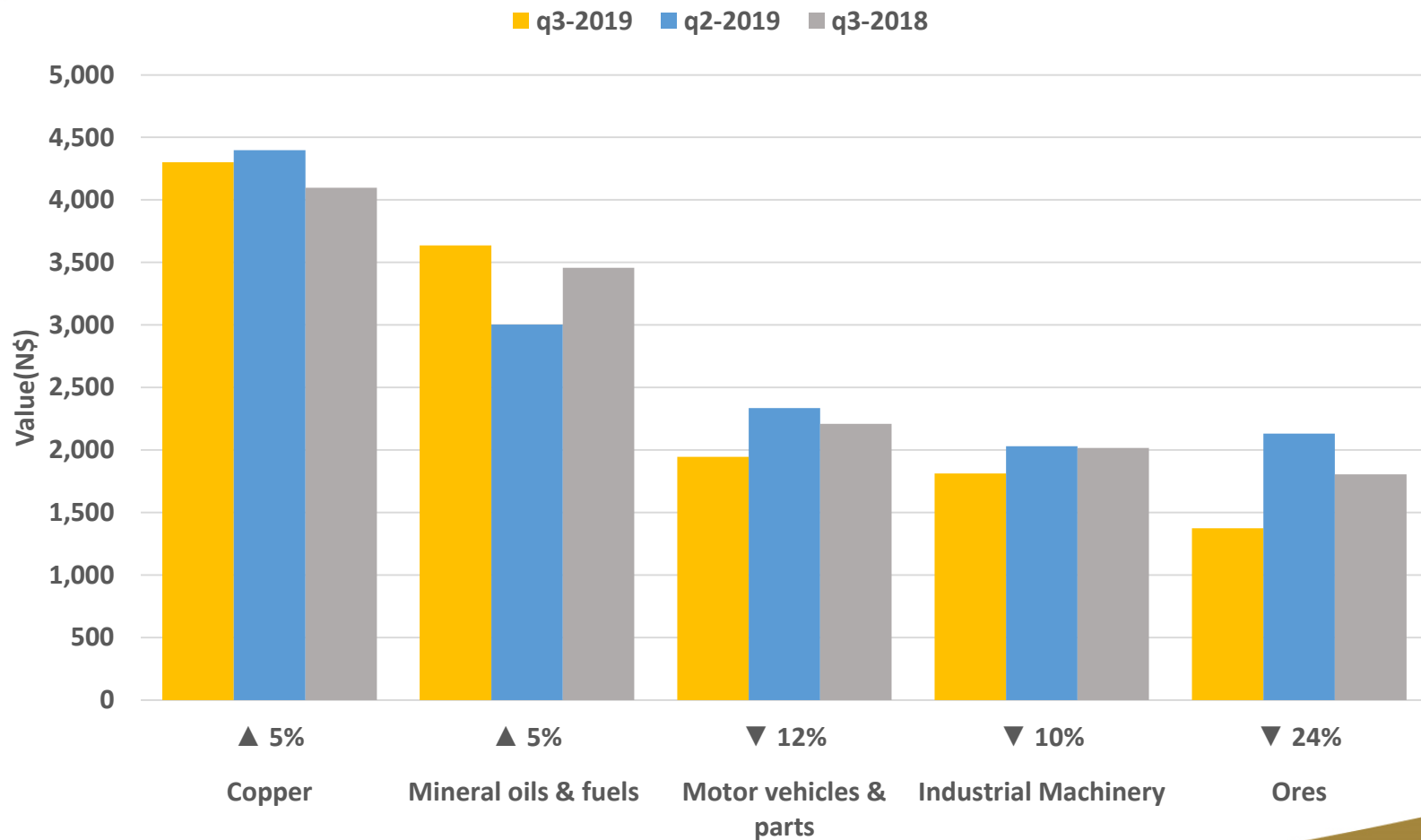

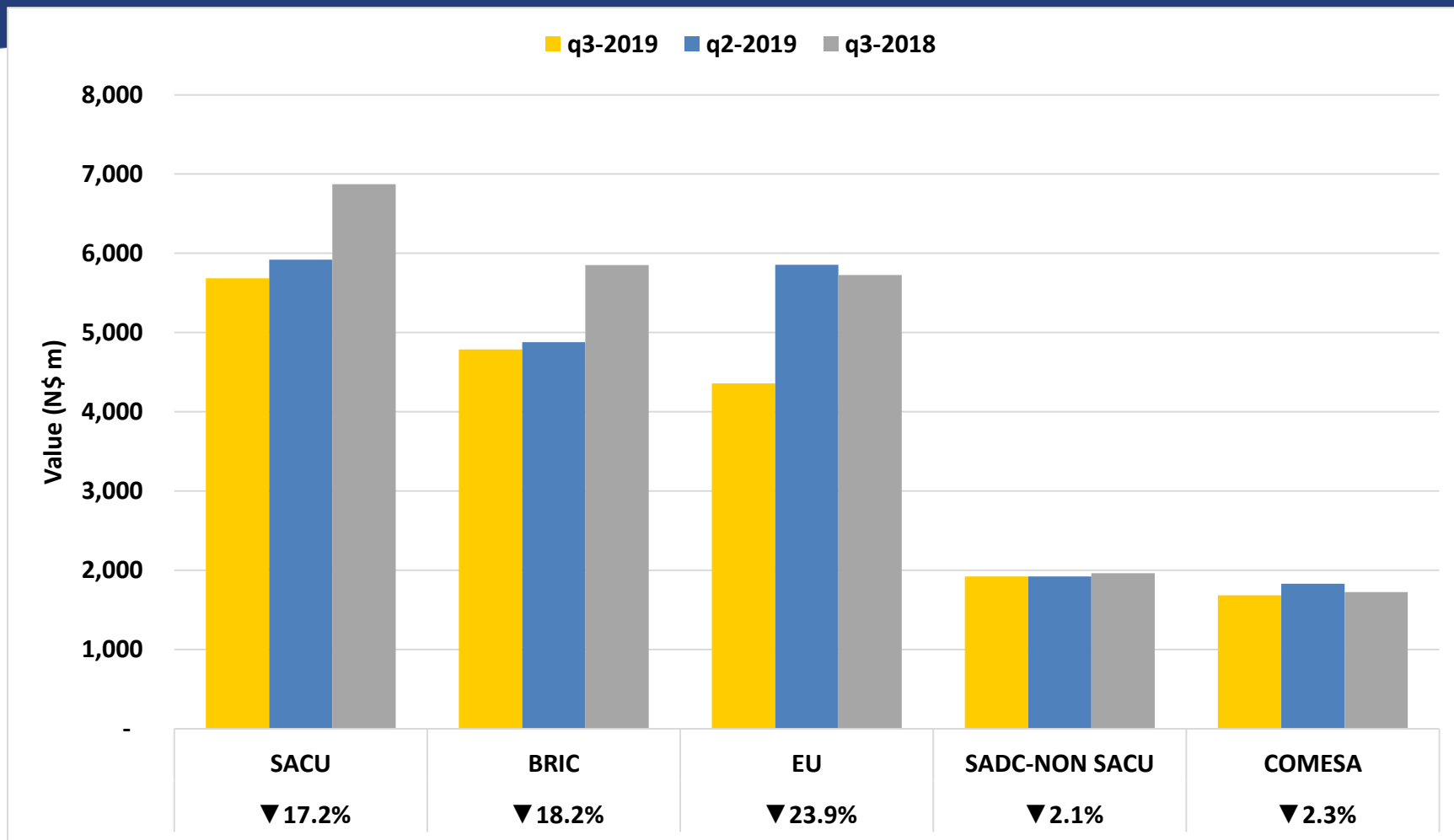
# Re-export commodities



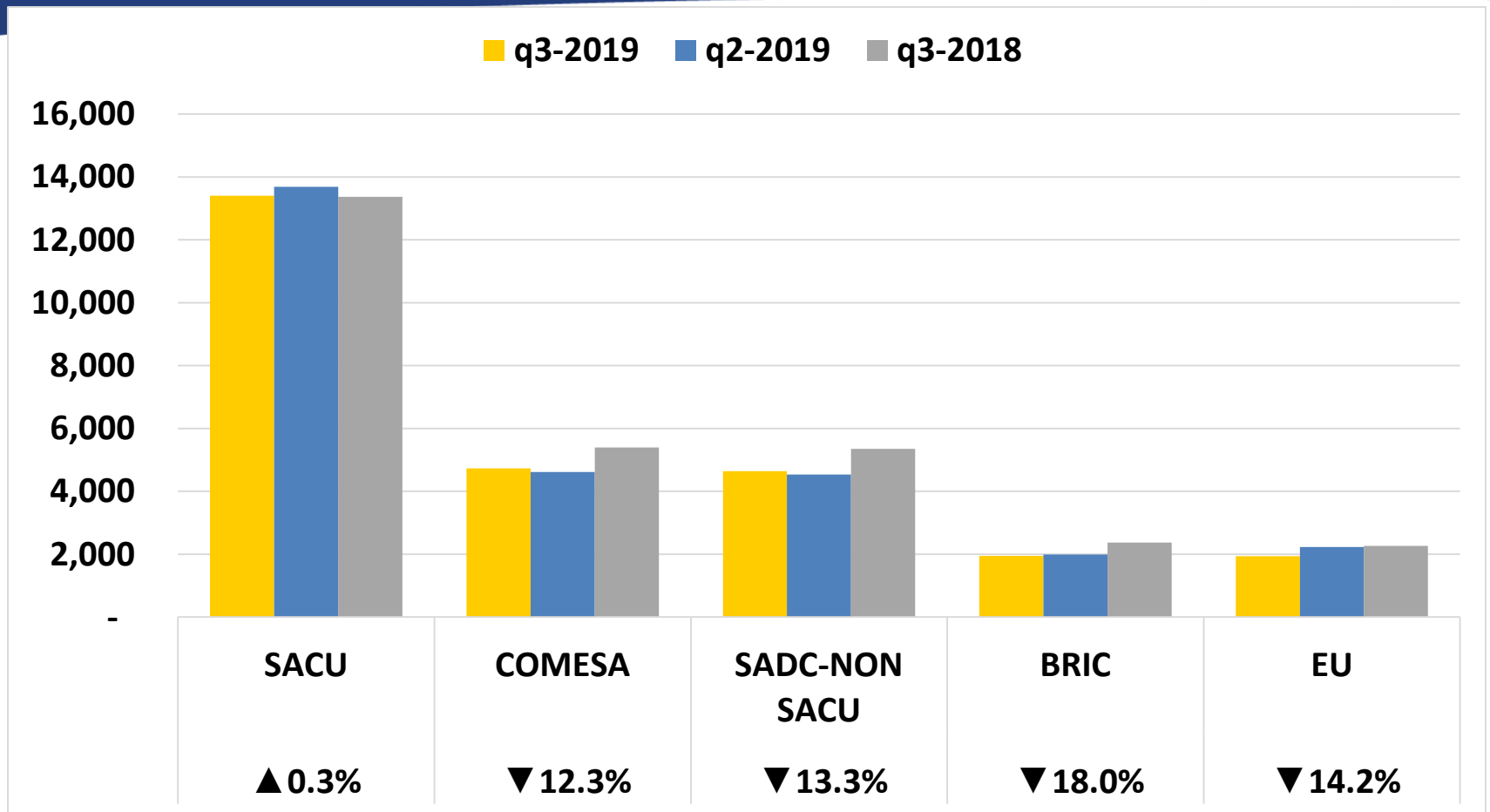
# Main Import Commodities



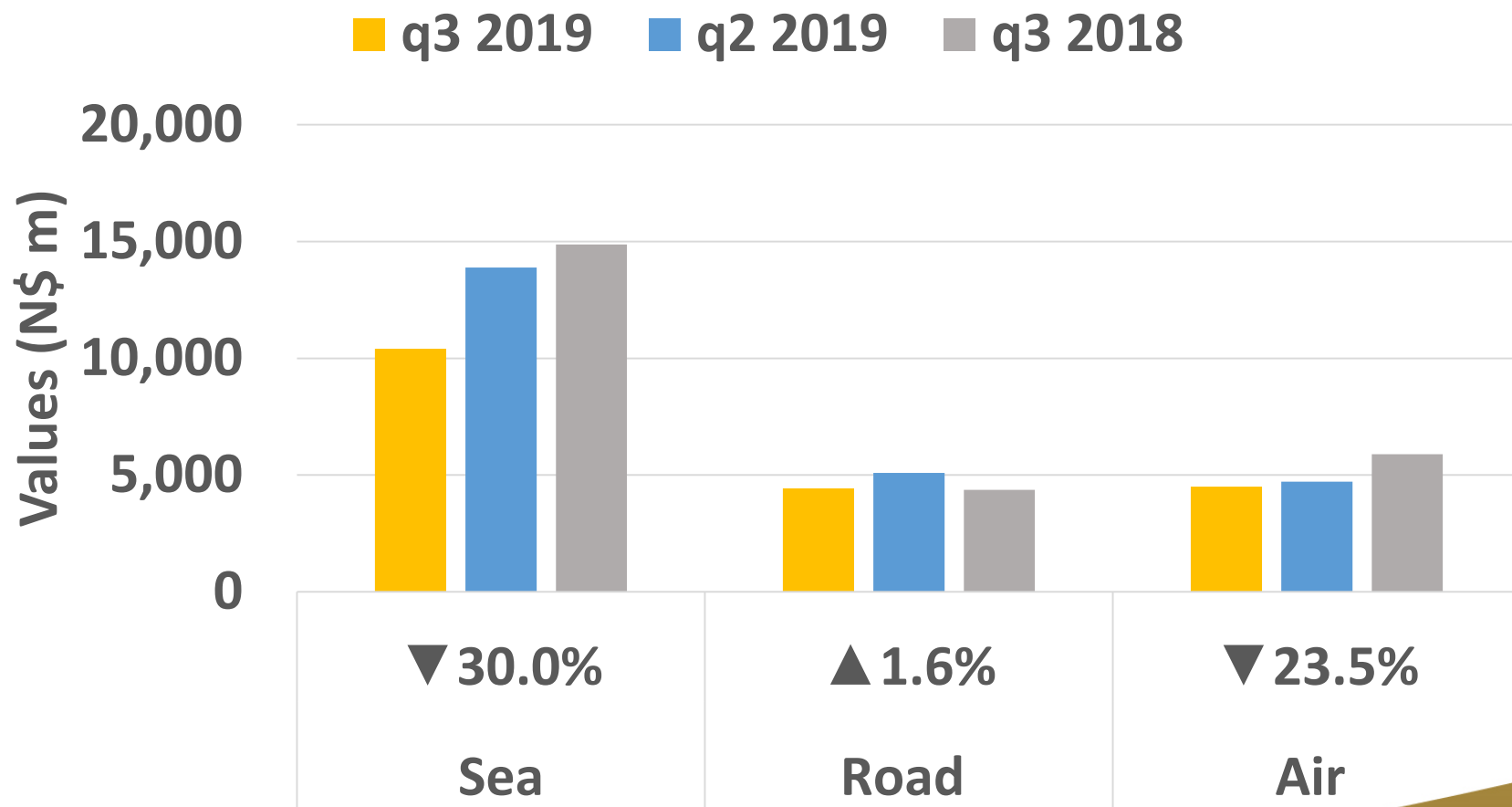
# Exports by Economic Blocs



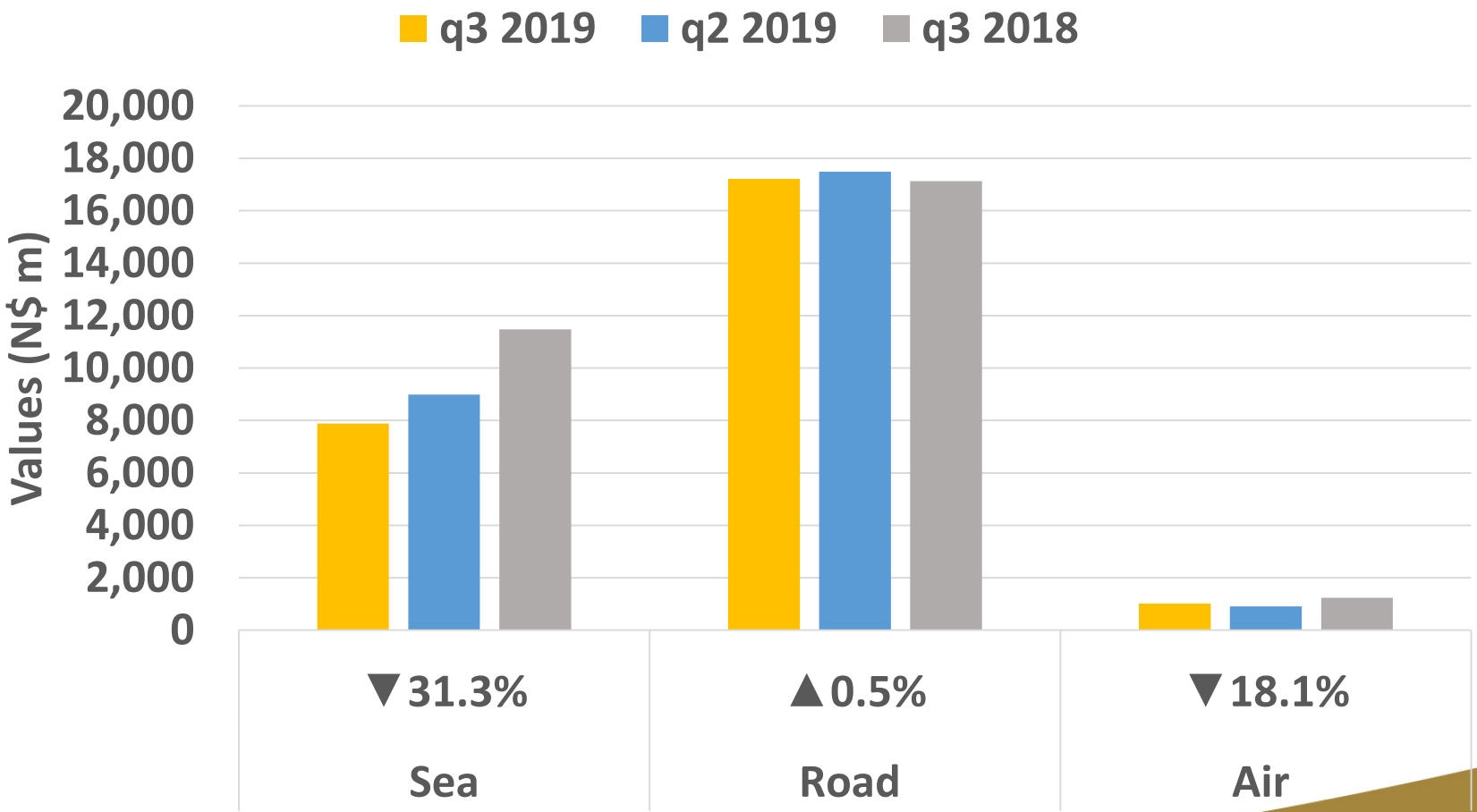
# Imports by Economic Blocs

# Conclusion

- **worsening** trade deficit
- Main export destination: **China**
- Main source of imports: **South Africa**
- Top exported commodities: **Copper**
- Top imported commodities: **copper**
- Imports: mainly via **road**, while exports: mostly by **sea**
- **Walvis Bay**: Main point of both exit (exports) and entry (imports)
