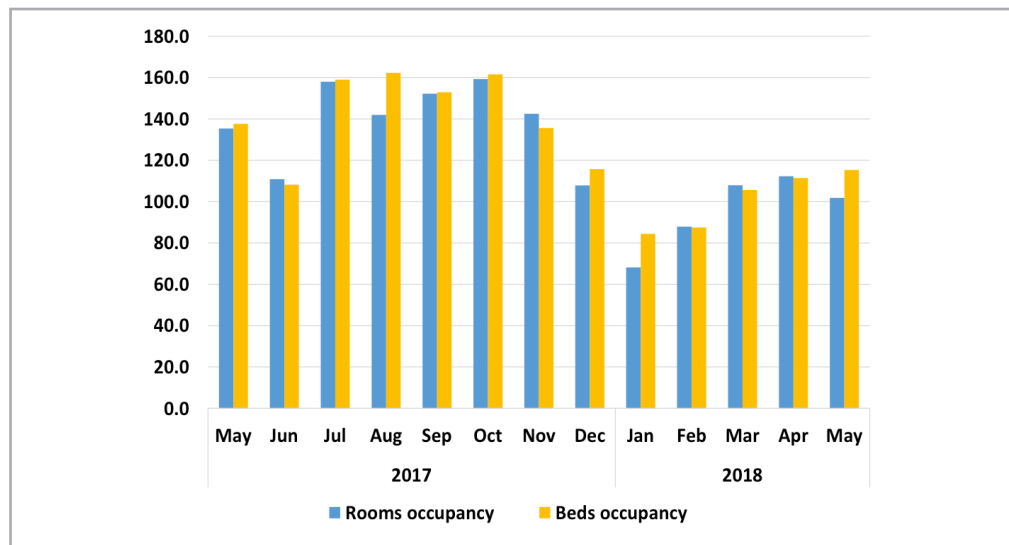


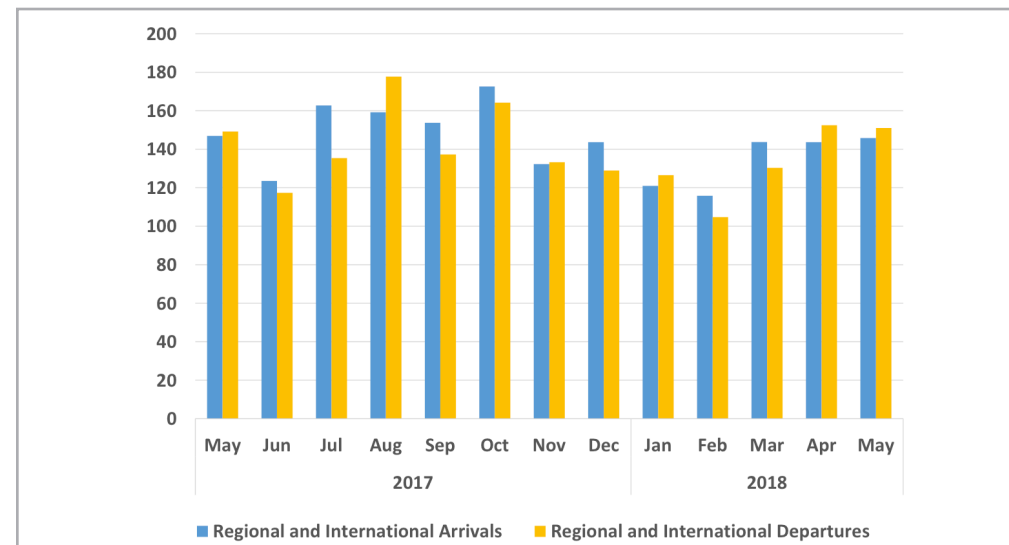


### Chart 1: Beds & Rooms Occupancy Indices



- The Hotels and Restaurants sector serves as a proxy to the tourism sector and it remains a priority sector under NDP5. The contribution of hotels and restaurants to GDP in 2017 was 2.5 percent compared to 2.3 percent in 2016.
- **The Rooms' Occupancy Index** recorded 101.8 basis points in May 2018 compared to 112.3 basis points recorded in April 2018. This translates into declines of 9.3 percent m/m and 24.8 percent y/y.
- The **Beds' Occupancy Index** registered 115.3 basis points during May 2018 while in April 2018 it stood at 111.4 basis points. This represents an increase of 3.5 percent m/m and a decline of 16.2 percent y/y.

### Chart 2: Regional & International Arrivals and Departures Indices



- The Index for **Regional and International Arrivals** recorded 145.8 basis points in May 2018 compared to 143.6 basis points registered in April 2018. This is an increase of 1.5 percent m/m and a decline of 0.7 percent y/y.
- **The Regional and International Departures Index** for May 2018 stood at 151.1 basis points while 152.5 basis points were recorded in the preceding month. This shows a decline of 0.9 percent m/m and an increase of 1.2 percent y/y.
