



Chart 1: Beds & Rooms Occupancy Indices

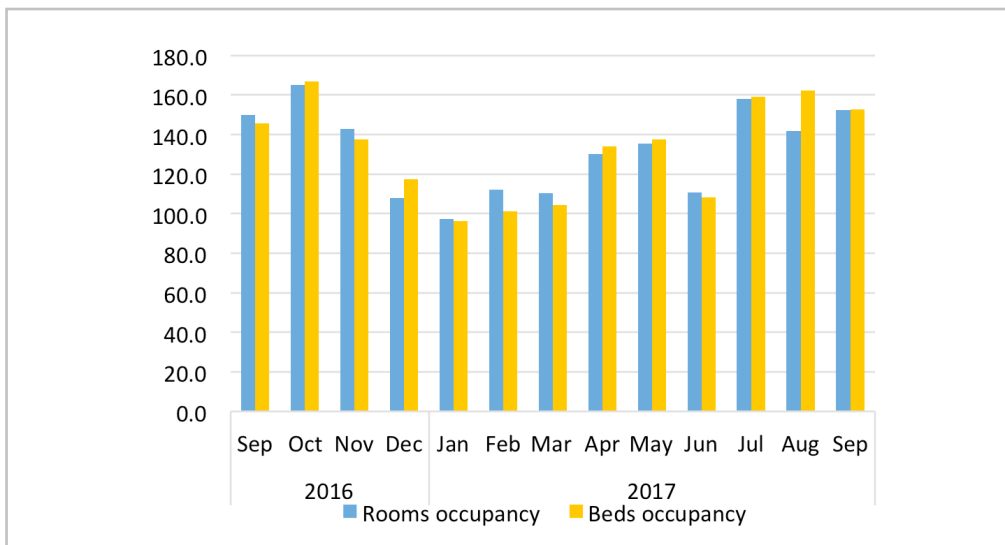
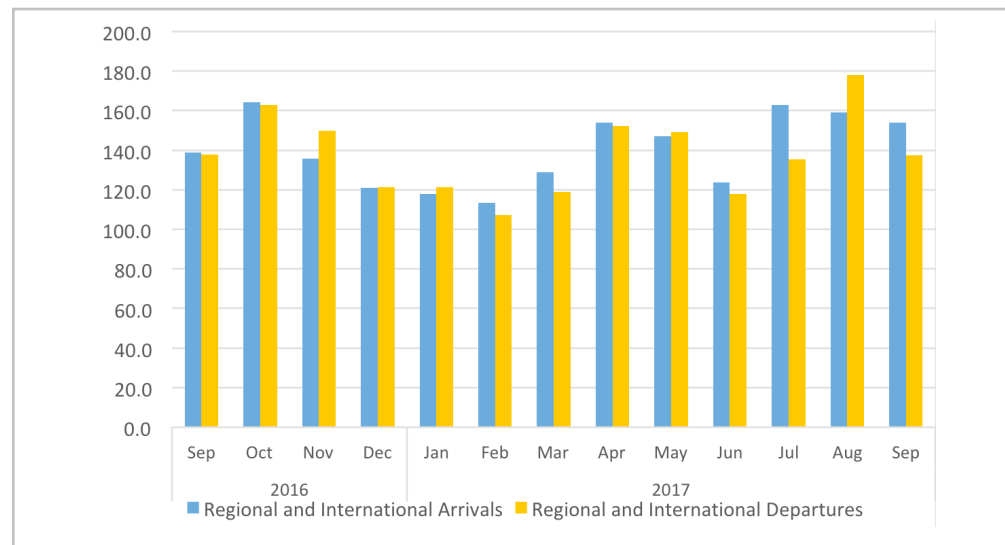


Chart 2: Regional & International Arrivals and Departures Indices



- The Hotels and Restaurants sector serves as a proxy to the tourism sector and it remains a priority sector under NDP5. The average contribution of hotels and restaurants to GDP for the last ten years is 1.8%.
- The Rooms' Occupancy Index stood at 152.3 basis points in September 2017 compared to 141.9 basis points recorded in August 2017. These are increases of 7.3 percent m/m and 1.5 percent y/y.
- The Beds' Occupancy Index recorded 152.9 basis points during September 2017 compared to 162.3 basis points registered in the preceding month. This represents a decline of 5.8 percent m/m and an increase of 5.0 percent y/y.

- The Regional and International Arrivals Index stood at 153.7 basis points in September 2017 compared to 159.2 basis points recorded in August 2017. This translates into a decline of 3.4 percent m/m and an increase of 10.8 percent y/y.
- The Regional and International Departures Index was 137.3 basis points in September 2017 compared to 177.7 basis points recorded in the preceding month. These represent declines of 22.8 percent m/m and 0.4 percent y/y.
